

TSSCC Test and Tune 2001

Tri-State Sports Car Council (TSSCC) is proud to present a test and tune on Saturday April 21, 2001 at Grissom AFB in Peru, Indiana.

This test and tune is for the moderate to experienced autocrosser and its main focus is on the car. Our goal is to give you the tools you need to help dial in your car to the limits of your class in autocrossing. Entry will be limited to 35 drivers. We have the site from dusk until dawn. We will start at 9:30 am and will finish as late as people want (before it gets dark). There will be 3 parts to the test and tune. The first part is the skidpad. There will be an approximately 250 foot skidpad that will allow you to dial in your car's static handling characteristics. The second part is the transitional phase. In this part, a 6-7 cone timed slalom section allows you to focus on the transitional characteristics of your car. Finally, there will be a short course (about 30 seconds long) comprised largely of sweeper and transitional maneuvers for you to put it all together. The cost is \$40 for the day. As usual, you will need to work during this event. All entrants will receive, via email (or via groups.yahoo.com/groups/chicagoautox), a starter's guide to tuning your car. This is written by Alex Tziortzis and goes through some rudimentary methods of optimizing the handling of your car. TSSCC members get priority on entry for this event. Entry must be received by April 13, 2001. Refunds will be made up until April 18th only when requested in writing.

Grissom AFB is a large site comprised of a concrete surface. It is located about 50 miles south of South Bend Indiana. Take Indiana state route 30 east to Plymouth and then south on Indiana state route 31 south for about 45 miles to Grissom AFB. Note that the **ONLY** entrance you are allowed to use is the entrance right next to the water tower off of US 31 (look for the big water tower on the right side). This is an active site and we could jeopardize any club running there in the future if any of us wanders off of the premises or enters from an unauthorized entrance. If you are not sure where you are going, call the event chair and ask. This is of the utmost importance. Violators will be ejected without refund and can be subject to arrest by military personnel.
